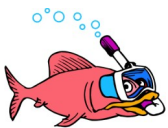
Instructors are Camp Gardens leaders and specialty camp instructors for each adventure.

*We meet at Mirasol Park daily then leave for off-site excursions. All campers must arrive by 8:45 am to catch the bus for our daily adventure. Specific days we leave extra early to catch a boat so campers must arrive at designated times or risk missing the experience.

Participant waivers are required for most adventures. Parents must complete at time of registration to reserve their child's spot in camp. No refunds for cancellations, missed days or partial weeks, as per our excursion providers. Daily schedule is subject to change.

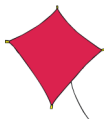
